Overview

Founded in 1992 by Karen and David Dillard, KD College Prep started as a test prep organization. Karen began her career as a teacher, and her perspective as an educator alongside the team's supportive and relational values, abilities, and commitment to each student has been the foundation of KD College Prep's success. Over the course of 30 years, KD College Prep has served over 82,000 students and offers support to students in four locations in the Dallas-Fort Worth area (Coppell, Flower Mound, Frisco, and Plano) as well as virtually. KD College Prep's college counseling program evolved as students and their families, appreciative of KD College Prep's philosophy and support around testing, began requesting support for the college search and application processes.

KD College Prep's college counseling program is guided by the idea that "college admissions isn't a game to be won-it's a fit to be found." The heart of the program is the Advantage Program which is grounded in small group sessions for students and their parents. Pinnacle Sessions, one to one counseling sessions, and Essay Boot Camps, six hours of guidance over the course of three days. complement the Advantage Program and may also serve as stand-alone programs. Members of the KD College Prep team belong to the National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC), Texas Association for College Admission Counseling (TACAC), and Independent Educational Consultants Association (IECA) and attend conferences and other professional development programs. They have hosted college fairs and partnered with local school districts, colleges and universities, Colleges that Change Lives, and DFW Admissions Regional Network (DARN) to provide free information sessions for their students and families, as well as the general public.

The KD College Prep team seeks a Senior College Counselor to serve as a leader in the Pinnacle program, collaborate in the ongoing development of the overall college counseling program, and provide college counseling and college admission expertise for the organization. This is a full-time, salaried position with benefits. Ideal candidates would reside in the Dallas-Fort Worth area, but the team is very open to candidates who live elsewhere. The team seeks candidates with significant college counseling and/or college admission experience, a highly collaborative workstyle, willingness to regularly work late afternoons, evenings, and weekends to accommodate the availability of students and parents, and a genuine enjoyment of working with teenagers and their families.



While KD College Prep's reach is broad and expansive, at heart, it is truly a family business with only 42 full-time employees. Karen and David Dillard built and grew the organization with a servant leadership mindset and practice, and they consistently demonstrate tremendous care for their students, colleagues, and community. Many on the leadership team are long-serving employees who began working as teachers or advisors and found opportunities to grow professionally.
