Position Description

Tower Hill seeks a Director of Enrollment Management (DEM) to begin in July 2025. The DEM will report to the Head of School and serve on the Senior Leadership Team. The position will be a new one for the Tower Hill community. Currently, enrollment is led by the Director of Advancement and Enrollment Management who has successfully supported the school's enrollment growth and fostered a warm and welcoming process for prospective students and their families. The aspirations and scope of the two offices, however, are not sustainable for one person, and after thoughtful reflection—including an in-depth and data-driven audit—school leadership decided to have the current Director lead advancement efforts and to add a Director of Enrollment Management. The DEM will lead a collaborative and hard-working team that includes a Director of Upper School Admission and Financial Aid, a Director of Lower and Middle School Admission, and an Admission Office Administrative Assistant. Collectively, they offer prospective students and their families a very welcoming and highly personalized experience through the admission process.

The Director of Enrollment Management oversees all facets of attracting, admitting, and retaining a qualified, diverse and dynamic student body which represents Tower Hill's motto, Multa Bene Facta, or Many Things Done Well, a philosophy about commitment, hard work, multifaceted learning, and extraordinary and healthy achievement.

The ideal candidate will be a passionate and stalwart promoter of Tower Hill School, a systems thinker with exceptional organizational and data analysis skills, and a proven and creative leader in admissions, recruitment and retention. The Director will develop and lead inclusive outreach efforts to draw families from diverse backgrounds and a larger geographic area to the school and will ensure that Tower Hill continues to enroll promising students who both thrive as part of the school community and who, in turn, contribute to the community as a whole.

This appointment comes at a pivotal time for Tower Hill School as the school seeks to make its reputation as the premier educational choice in Wilmington known beyond the immediate area in order to make Tower Hill a "destination school" for families of talented children of strong character in communities not geographically or historically inclined to consider the school.

- Seeking and using data in developing strategy and decision making.
- Close and strategic collaboration with the communication team in developing a thoughtful and regular cadence of outreach to prospective students and families.
- Development of systems around recruitment, assessment, and retention in collaboration with colleagues.

About the Head of School

Sarah Baker became the 11th Head of Tower Hill School in 2023. She joined the Tower Hill community in 2021 as Head of Upper School. She served as Assistant Head of Upper School at Collegiate School in Richmond, VA from 2016 to 2021. Her prior experience also includes teaching Latin and History to Middle and Upper School students at Agnes Irwin School in Bryn Mawr, PA and serving her alma mater, The Episcopal Academy in Newtown Square, PA, in the Development Office and as an Upper School Form Dean and Chair of the English Department. Sarah earned her B.A. at Duke University and her M.Ed. at the University of Pennsylvania.

- Ability to think and act strategically and to effectively operationalize strategic ideas and goals.
- Demonstrated leadership, engagement in, and a commitment to diversity, equity, inclusion.
- Possess a deep understanding of human development, demonstrated by knowledge of child development PreK-12, a growth mindset, and belief in the capacity of humans to be lifelong learners.
- Bachelor's degree required, advanced degree preferred.
